Criteria:

- * Must be planning on or attending a community college majoring in an agriculturally related field.
- * Must be a graduate of (or about to graduate from) a Yamhill County public or private high school, Western Mennonite School, Perrydale School or be home schooled within Yamhill County.
- * Must complete our application form and return together with two letters of reference and high school transcripts.
- * Postmark or email submission by **April 10, 2021**.

The successful applicant will be expected to attend a meeting of Yamhill County Women for Agriculture and give a short presentation.

The scholarship will be awarded by funds being deposited directly to the student's chosen school after enrollment.
